Project Lifeline, formed by North Cotswolds Rotary early in 2022 has provided support and supplies totalling over £100,000 to Ukraine by working with the network of Rotary Clubs and other relief organisations in the UK, Poland and Ukraine.

Work is ongoing and trailers of supplies and equipment are regularly delivered to Ukraine based on the needs requested.

Greystones Run

The 2023 Bourton on the Water Greystones 10k Trail Run took place on Sunday July 9th 2023. 135 runners participated in this trail run through the beautiful Cotswold countryside at the Greystones Farm Nature Reserve.

The race was won by Pat Davis in 38 minutes 23 seconds. He was closely followed by his dad, Mark, and the third home was Daniel Pebody.

The first home in the ladies race was Rachel See of Cheltenham Harriers in 42 minutes 14 seconds

The event raised £1,700 which will be supporting the Gloucestershire Wildlife Trust's work at Greystones Farm Nature Reserve, in protecting the environment.
